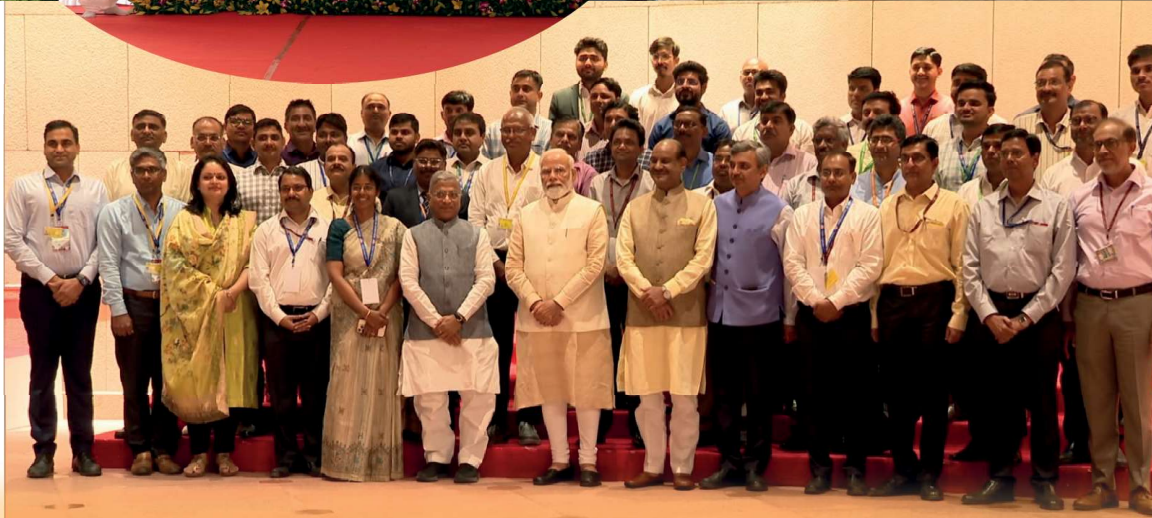

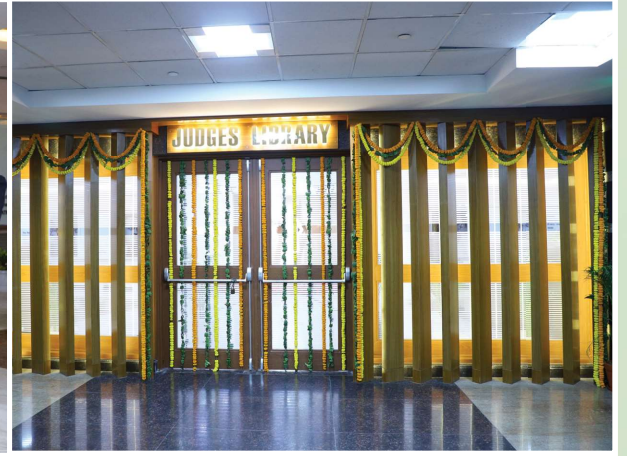

Preliminary estimates for over 4,437 works amounting to ₹63,729 crore submitted to the clients.

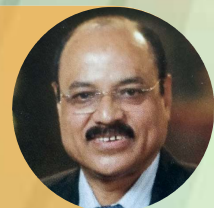
Over 39 works costing ₹335 crore completed during the FY 2023-24 upto 31st May 2023.

DYNAMIC FAÇADE LIGHTING: A NEW WAY OF LIGHTING FOR HISTORICAL, CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS MONUMENTS AT LEH, UT OF LADAKH.

Introduction:



The Land of Lama i.e., Ladakh known to be a broken piece of Moon is not only famous for its picturesque scenic beauty but also houses a number of monuments having huge historical, cultural & religious significance. Its picturesque scenic beauty is not only unique but also not found anywhere in the world. Its scenic beauty includes mighty hills, breath taking passes, showstopping Lakes, fascinating plains & deep valleys. The majestic Ladakhi architectural marvels build in medieval times magnifies its beauty to manifold making it to the top destination for the tourists.

The eye-catching historical, cultural and religious monuments are available across the length breadth of the UT of Ladakh are the tempting area for the tourist and local people. These monuments are being decorated by using the crude method of lighting like, different colour LED strip. These crude methods of lighting gives a shabby look to the structure especially when these structures have huge cultural and religious significance.

CPWD: The Lead Taker:

Leh Project Zone, CPWD, took the lead and conceptualize the idea to illuminate such majestic monuments with a new way of aesthetic lighting by illuminating these monuments with Dynamic Façade Lighting. The idea of illuminating these monuments was never conceived by the Administration of UT of Ladakh. On persuasion and yearlong discussion with the UT Administration, Deputy Commissioner cum Chief Executive Officer, Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Counsel Leh agreed to illuminate some of the monument in the Leh City with dynamic façade lighting. It is pertinent to mention here that all these projects are completed in a very short timeline of only 15 days. The Dynamic Façade Lighting of all these monuments were inaugurated by the Chief Executive Councillor (Cabinet Minister Rank), LAHDC, Leh in the august presence of the Hon'ble member of Parliament, UT of Ladakh, Principal Secretary, UT of Ladakh, Chief Engineer cum Executive Director, CPWD & other dignitaries of UT of Ladakh.

Dynamic Façade lighting with RGB LED Technology:

The million-colour combination are possible by using state-of-the-art RGB LED technology having over 1 lakh burning hours. All new light fittings are dust, vermin and moisture proof with outdoor weather protection in-line of the climatic condition of the UT of Ladakh, of the highest order (IP-66) with robust design. While installing these LED fixtures, utmost care has been taken to avoid any damage to the monument structure. A number of themes have been designed based on the various events of local, national and international significance which include a dedicated theme for each occasion like Republic Day, Independence Day, World

Environment Day, World Water Day, World Earth Day, World Women day, Buddha Purnima, Gandhi Jayanti, Holi, Diwali or any another theme can be think-off in future.



Leh Gate:

The Leh Gate is located in the epicentre of the Leh City. The Leh Gate not only symbolize the entry point to the Leh city but also symbolize the cultural and religious aspect as the three small structure at the top of the Leh gate reflects the compassion, wisdom and Power. After the illumination the structure gives magnificent look which can be easily visualized from the images.

The King Singay Namgyal Chowk:

King Singay Namgyal was a 17th century Namgyal dynasty King of Ladakh. A Buddhist, he was noted for his immense work in building monasteries, palaces and shrines in Ladakh and is known as the "Lion King". He is regarded as the one of the charismatic personalities in Leh. This monument is located at Leh Manali Highway. After the illumination the structure gives magnificent look which can be easily visualized from the images.



Stupa near Petrol Pump Chowk:

Stupas are hemispherical structure that symbolises Bodh religion. The stupa holds religious, architectural, cultural as well as tourist significance. Across the Buddhist religion the stupa is considered as the holy place of worship and also symbolizes with the enlightenment and also as victory of good over evil. This monument is located at Leh Manali Highway. After the illumination the structure gives magnificent look which can be easily visualized from the images.



Shanti stupa : Future Projects:

Shanti Stupa is a Buddhist white-domed Stupa (chorten) on a hilltop in Chanspa, Leh district, Ladakh, in north India. It was built in 1991 by Japanese Buddhist Bhikshu, Gyomyo Nakamura. The Shanti Stupa holds the relics of the Buddha at its base, enshrined by the 14th Dalai Lama. The Stupa has become a tourist attraction not only due to its religious significance but also due to its location which provides panoramic views of the surrounding landscape.

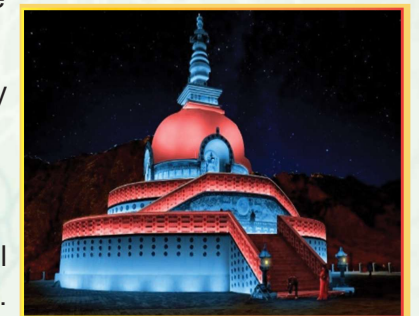
The Shanti Stupa was built by both Japanese and Ladakhi Buddhists. Original idea was started by The Great King Ashoka and Nichidatsu Fujii implement his idea to modern time as a symbol of peace. The mission of Nichidatsu Fujii was to build Shanti Stupa as a symbol of peace.

After the illumination the structure gives a magnificent look which can be easily visualized from the images.



Way Forward :

The illumination of these monuments with the Dynamic Façade Lighting will not only give due recognition to them but also help to boost the tourism in Leh. In future, various other natural areas like mountain projection with the use of LASER & musical dancing fountain with laser light and sound show etc. will give a boost to the tourism sector in the Leh, UT of Ladakh.

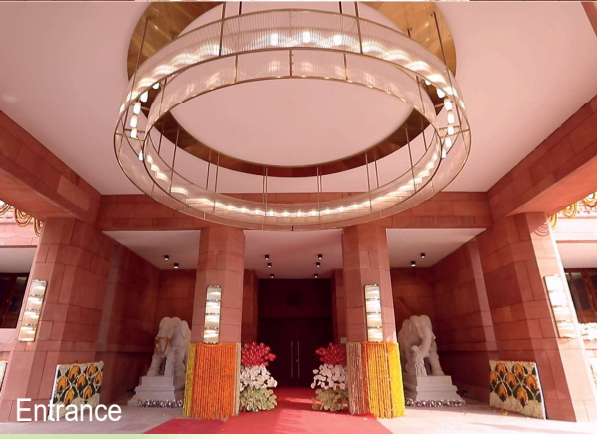
