Born on July 16, 1961, Shri Vinit Kumar Jayaswal secured his B Tech Degree in Civil Engineering from the Institute of Technology, BHU (now IIT-BHU) in the year 1981 and joined Central Engineering Service (Civil), CPWD as Assistant Executive Engineer in June 1983 through UPSC Engineering Services Examination 1981. He also holds Law Degree from Delhi University.

He assumed the office of Director General, CPWD on 01st June, 2020. As Director General, CPWD, he is responsible to the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for efficient administration and overall professional control of public works within the jurisdiction of CPWD.

During his illustrious career of 37 years in different capacities in CPWD from Assistant Executive Engineer to Special Director General, he had vast and varied experience in the fields of structural design, planning and construction of works, project management, maintenance of prestigious buildings, vigilance, administration, e-governance, arbitration and legal matters. During this period, he served at Allahabad, Bengaluru, Chennai, Delhi, Guwahati and Kolkata.
